NOTICE TO ALL LIVING AT RAND AIRPORT AND BOKSBURG SHELTERS

The Constitutional Court ruling refers:

- *The Court ruling allows for a separation of people that are legal in the country from those that are not legal.*
- *Illegal immigrants should be removed from the shelters and taken to the Deportation/Repatriation Centre.*
- *People that are legal in the country should be reintegrated into communities.*
- *Shelters can be consolidated into one for administrative and financial reasons.*
- *Persons who received financial assistance for rental accommodation may be requested to move out of the shelters.*

**KINDLY BE ADVISED OF THE FOLLOWING ARRANGEMENTS IN ORDER TO
GIVE EFFECT TO THE CONSTITUTIONAL COURT'S
RULING AND DECISIONS OF THE GAUTENG PROVINCIAL
GOVERNMENT.**

- All persons who have applied for funding so that they are able to find their own alternative accommodation will be receiving this funding on Tuesday, 30 September 2008 from 08:00 onwards to enable the shelters to be closed as per Gauteng Government decision.
- Persons who refused to apply for financial assistance, but still living in the two shelters by (30 September 2008), should make sure that they have alternative accommodation by this date since all the shelters are going to be closed on this day.

Failure to meet the deadline date of 30 September 2008 will be dealt with in terms of the Constitution of the Republic of South Africa utilising any of the resources available to ensure compliance with the Constitutional Court ruling and decisions of the Gauteng Provincial Government.
