

INVITATION TO DEPENDANTS OF REFUGEES WHO ARE IN MATRIC OR WISH TO FURTHER STUDIES OR HAVE AN EMPLOYMENT OFFER, TO APPLY FOR IDs OR TRAVEL DOCUMENTS 08 JULY 2021

As part of the effort to restore services in a manner that helps to prevent and combat the spread of Coronavirus, the Department of Home Affairs wishes to invite the following categories of dependants of Refugees to submit online applications for IDs and/or travel documents, by email.

This Invitation, for Refugee dependants' online ID/Travel Document applications, was made after the Directions that were gazetted on 30 June 2021, in line with the National State of Disaster Regulations.

Qualifying categories of dependants of refugees are the following:

- Dependents who are 16 years and above and are in matric/Grade 12,
- Dependants who wish to further their studies at an institution of higher learning,
- · Dependants who wish to take up employment, and
- Dependants who were previously delinked from the principal applicant's files and wish to apply for an ID/Travel Document on the basis of the above circumstances (that is, in Grade 12/further study/employment).

The applicants must submit supporting documents when submitting their applications (namely: letter from school/letter of employment/letter of acknowledgement or admission from the prospective institution of higher learning).

HOW TO APPLY?

Dependants of refugees should send an email request to the email address listed below, with the supporting document(s) attached.

An automatic reply will be sent to the applicant, and will state the date, time and office of appointment where the applicant will go to complete the application.

The applications will be processed in terms of section 30 of the Refugee Act, Act No. 130 of 1998, as amended.
