CoRMSA would like to remind and foresight all citizens, young and old around the globe that all children (asylum seekers, refugees and migrants' dependants including statelessness and unaccompanied and local children) are protected through the United Nations Convention on the Rights of the Child (UNCRC), a human rights treaty which sets out the civil, political, economic, social, health and cultural rights of all children. The UNCRC consists of 54 articles that set out children's rights and how governments should work together to make them available to all children. The UNCRC strongly sets out the need for legal and other protection of the child before and after birth.
